Windfang by Dario Wokurka marks a loose epilogue to this earlier formation.


A flat plinth made of rag rugs on the floor, watercolours as slides and their translations into originals on the wall.

Wokurka renders these referential watercolours in a persistently casual manner, thus creating the visualisation of a quasi-algorithm that appears incalculable from an outside perspective.

A slideshow that through its surprising and its redundant moments both rewards and frustrates our viewing habits and expectations regarding images.
